Acton Town Hall Complex

Ealing Council is creating a new integrated hub in Acton with a leisure centre, library, community centre and civic facilities at Acton Town Hall. Initial designs are being prepared to incorporate the best of the site's heritage assets into the scheme.

In March 2011 Ealing Council will be commencing selections utilising the IESE framework for a design and build partner to take forward the scheme.

The creation of this integrated hub, due for completion in Q1 2014, will release council-owned sites and buildings for disposal including:

- The existing Grade 2 listed library – potential for office, retail or residential
- The remainder of the Grade 2 listed Acton Town Hall – potential for residential development
- Priory Community Centre – for residential development.

A draft Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) for Acton Town Hall and surroundings has been developed to support the site's development opportunities and is available at www.ealing.gov.uk/planpol



The revitalised hub complex aims to provide a 25-metre 8-lane swimming pool, a learner pool, a café, a gym, a modern library and flexible community and civic spaces. This will release the Priory Community Centre, Town Hall and library for residential and retail development.

The complex

This 1.3ha complex is at the heart of Acton town centre and is well located on the Uxbridge Road between White City and Ealing Broadway, with excellent connections into Central London.

The complex currently comprises three main sites owned by the council:

- Acton Town Hall (Town Hall, Baths & Kings Rooms)
- Acton Library
- Priory Community Centre.

A public car park on Salisbury Street serves the location.
